What should you do?

Go to the OCMW / Social House of your municipality and ask if you are eligible for the minimum supply of natural gas. Even if you are not a customer of the OCMW.

If your application is approved, the amount will be put on your card (with a classic budget meter) or the amount will be put on the meter (with a digital meter with budget meter function).
