

## You are registered for the elections. What now?

### City of Ghent investigates if you fullfill all the conditions

- These are the 2 options:
  - A = You are allowed to vote
  - B = You are not allowed to vote

### OPTIE A: You fullfill all the conditions = You are allowed to vote

- You receive a letter from the City of Ghent
- You MAY now always vote in municipal council elections (not for the province)
- You will receive a invitaion letter to vote a few weeks before the elections

  - The address of the polling station is on the convocation letter
  - You take your identity card and this convocation letter with you
  - You vote once for the municipal council

### OPTIE B: You don't fullfill the conditions = You are not allowed to vote

- You receive a letter from the City of Ghent
- You are not allowed to vote for the elections on October 13th, 2024
- You may try again to register for the elections in 2030
